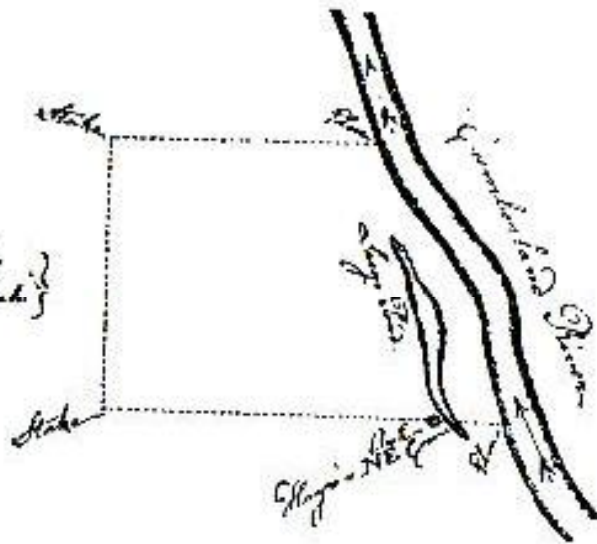

Surveyed for Peter Brantley - - - - - Six hundred & forty  
Acres of land agreeable to the enclosed warrant N<sup>o</sup> 581 (the Date dated  
August 17<sup>th</sup> 1786 - -) of which the above is a true Plot bounded as follows

Beginning at an Oak & Pine William Hays's Northeast Corner  
running East Seventy Poles to an Elm & two Beeches on the Bank of Cumbe-  
land River - thence down said River according to its several Courses three  
hundred & twenty-eight Poles to an Elm & Beech - thence West two hundred &  
seventy-one Poles to a Stake - thence South two hundred & eighty-nine Poles  
to a Stake thence East three hundred & forty-two Poles to the beginning -
